



Manage Pages Top Level — Stats




At the top level of the manage pages section is a dashboard of statistics and important settings. From this page the owner can jump to any section to manage

General Settings/Look & Feel



The general look and the feel of the page may be modified by the user including:

- + Skins
- + Fonts
- + Colors
- + Backgrounds

--

Parameters should be set by Mlab to editing for instance font size should be only a few choices

--

As the modifications are made the object being edited updates itself automatically to show the new change. Once the settings are made to the user's liking they can preview the changes or save it to apply to their live site.

--


For the advanced user style sheet code can be modified by selecting the advanced button.

Eventually the Skinning API should be opened to the public



Profile: Vitals & Interests



All aspects of the user's profile (including tags) can be updated except for their user name. If the owner wants a new user name they have to go through the registration process again

Profile: Mobile Phone



The mobile phone information may be modified at any time.

If any information is changed the phone must go through the MLab verification process again



Settings and Preferences for Message Center



The message center should have some preferences surrounding it as to how the user would like to be notified of activity and who can send messages

--

The default settings for these preferences are noted to the left.


--

If the user selects no-one in the first prefernve then all of the preferences below it become disabled except for number of messages per a page

--

Only if the user says they want to have mobile alerts sent does the pulldown box become activated

Settings and Preferences for Friends



When managing friends the user can see who her friends are, who may become friends (pending), who she has blocked, and the ability to invite more friends.

--

Under the Active tab the user can see her friends and then be able to see if they are mobile enabled, if they have updated their pages, and then they can communicate with a friend or visit their friend's pages

-

Updates are any signifigant changes made within the last 48 hours. The update status is not based on the owner's last vist to that friend's page



--


The user can also view past invites by selecting the link in the grey bar

Settings and Preferences for Friends: Invite



When viewing sent invites the user can see who they have sent invites to and the status of the invite

--

Status includes

- + Accepted member has accepted
- + Declined member has declined
- + Pending awaiting member response
- + Nothing person is out of network

--

If the recipient has not responded within 15 and 30 days a automated message will be sent to the recipient on behalf of the owner reminding them of the owner's invite.



Invites should be cleared after 30 days

The user can create and edit blogs


All blogs are public

Settings and Preferences for Blogs: New/Edit Post



When creating or editing the owner must have a blog topic and text that goes on the top level. The user may decide they don't want to make a long blog on their home page so they can enter copy in the extended text box. Once published this adds a more button to the blog to make the reader open the blog in a new window t view the whole thing.

To assist in bloging there should be a WYSIWYG editor

The owner can decide to save the blog as a draft or post right away

Also the user can decide whether or not they want comments on their block and if they do if they want to be notified of the new comments


A picture may be added from the owner's My Pics gallery by selecting a pic icon in the editor bar

A blog is limited to 160 characters


Settings and Preferences for Blogs: mBlogging



Mobile blogging can be done using the email address provided by the system



Settings and Preferences for My Pics



In the My Pics management area the user can add and edit their, pics, albums, and slideshows

--

The section defaults to the user's pic library


--

The pic gallery is always private in order for pics to become viewable by anyone outside of the owner the pics must be added to an album

-

From the pic library pics can be batched for deletion, move to an album, or create an album based on the selection of pics, or send to user's phone

Settings and Preferences for My Pics (Detail)



When a pic is selected from the user's pic gallery the user can modify all of the components noted to the left.

The pic can be added to multiple albums so that the picture only has to be loaded once

Also there is an embed URL that allows the owner and others to embed the image in communications on the MLab site.



Settings and Preferences for My Pics (Albums)



Albums can be created and edited to help the user organize their pics. When viewed by a friend the album may be viewed as pics or as an automated slideshow


--

The user may decide globally or per item whether or not comments should be allowed, and if they are if the owner should be notified as well as if tags can be edited by friends

Settings and Preferences for My Pics (New/Edit Slideshow)



The album/slideshow is oriented around the aspect ratio of a mobile phone

--

After an album/slideshow is selected or created the user is presented with the options noted to the left. From this point the user can preview their slideshow, delete it, and edit it.

--

The user can:

- + add/change music
- + mute the music
- + add more images to the show
- + set resting periods
- + and set transitions

Also there is a set of actions for each image whic are remove, edit, and move.

--

The user can delete theimage from the show - this not delete from the library pool

--

The user can edit the image (demonstrated on the next page)

--

The user can move the image to another slot in the show

--

Adding an image will add the image after the slide the user is currently on. So if the user is on slide two when the add picture button is selecte the new image becomes slide three

-

Any permissions set here overrides the global permissions set on the album's list page

--

A slideshow can only display one all encompassing caption and one set of tags likewise viewers can only comment on the whole slideshow



selecting the done buton closes the drawer





Settings and Preferences for My Pics (New/Edit Album)



The viewing visitor may view an album as a slideshow or as a series of pics that the viewer can go through randomly


--

Here the pics in the album can be removed or be edited which would take the owner to the pic's detail page.

--

When the viewer is looking at the album in this way the viewer can see the average user rating for each individual pic as well as see a caption and tags for each pic as well as the caption and tags for the album/slideshow likewise viewers can comment on each individual pic as well as add tags

Settings and Preferences for My Pics (Mobile Settings)



Users can send images from their phone to their My Pics area via a special email address

--

The pics are only vieable by friends until the owner changes permissions on them

--

If a pic/pics are uploaded from the phone an album is automatically created with the date of upload as its name that houses the newly uploaded pics of the day

This album creation only happens if the preference noted to the left is set to anyone or friends




